Project Scope:

The project began in April 2010 and is expected to be fully completed in June, 2012. This project encompasses 5-miles of asphalt pavement which was completely removed and replaced. New subgrade established and cement stabilized. New storm drainage systems installed including three box culverts, 13' x 5', 10' x 8', and a 10' x 9'. Due to the change to the roadway grading, new drive aprons and intersection tie-ins were necessary. New intersection signalization required to assist with the increased traffic flow.
