Project Scope:

The station is being moved to the southeast corner of the Rapid Corridor and East 55th Street, near the end of I-490, to make the station more visible.

RTA stations will serve both heavy-rail and light-rail customers.

Because of a 30-foot elevation difference, the \$10 M project includes:

- Two station buildings
- An elevator to make the station ADA compliant
- A parking lot
- Public art

Project Services:

- Performs daily construction inspection.
- Writing daily construction activity reports.
- Tracking materials, labor and equipment.
- Reviewing pay requests.
- Reviewing change requests.
- Answering requests for information.
- Scheduling and verifying testing.
- Attending progress meetings.
- Acts as a liaison between the contractor and the GCRTA assisting in resolving conflicts.
